Purposes and Amount of the Scholarship

The primary goal of the CTM Scholarship Awards is to support students entering/continuing post-secondary education in the fields of Business, Finance, Agricultural Studies, or Insurance who are striving to enhance their life skills and contribute positively to their communities.

Applications are welcome from students who are Canadian permanent residents or citizens, under the age of 25 years (*as of December 31, 2024*), who reside in southwestern Ontario. Eligible applicants must be entering or currently enrolled in a post-secondary program related to Business, Finance, Agricultural Studies, or Insurance, within Canada.

Prize: \$1,500⁰⁰

CTM Scholarship Awards (2x Winners)

Prize: \$1,000⁰⁰/Each

Scholarship Terms and Conditions

The application must be fully completed and received by CTM in Waterford or Kilworth, by **4:30 P.M. on November 15, 2024**.

The application must include the answer to the Scholarship Topic noted below.

Proof of enrollment in a full time **post-secondary educational program** (including apprenticeships and co-op programs) must be provided from the **Registrar's Office** prior to scholarship funds being released. The school term can be any term that starts in the twelve-month period, beginning September 1st, 2024.

This scholarship is **not** available to the children of any CTM staff or directors.

Successful applicants will be notified by December 31, 2024.



2024 Scholarship Topic

Please consider the following and answer the question “**Propose an innovative solution to Ontario’s challenges with the current cost of housing or groceries. How would you implement this solution, and what impact do you expect it to have?**”

The answer should be in the form of an essay of between 750 and 1000 words or applicants can submit a video presentation. *Essay submissions should be typed and double-spaced.*
